Cemeteries

Some of our <u>cemetery records</u> have been digitised including Owaka, Balclutha, Kaitangata, and Tapanui. However, not all our cemetery records have been digitised. For Milton and Lawrence, visit or ring the local library who hold the original cemetery records.
